TASTER MEMBERSHIP

Terms & Conditions

1. A Taster member's membership is for two months from the first of the month following receipt of the subscription fee.
2. A new Taster member will attend a short induction/interview with the club professional to explain the club rules and etiquette etc before taster membership is accepted.
3. A Taster member may only start his round when the professional shop is open during normal business hours.
4. A Taster member will be issued with a coloured identification badge which must be displayed at all times on the course. This will show the category of membership. If you fail to show or display this badge you will be asked to leave the course until you have one.
5. A Taster Member shall be entitled to play the course Monday to Friday and after 11.00am on a Sunday.

The Council may at times give priority to bookings from visitors, societies etc. It is advisable that all members to check with the Club Professional (01925 762013) for tee availability before playing to avoid disappointment. The times when the course is booked can be found on the course notice board for member's convenience.

6. A Taster member may introduce three visitors on any day at the reduced rate. Any visitor may only be introduced to the Club, at the reduced rate, a maximum of 6 times in any one calendar year.
7. A Taster member may apply for a handicap certificate on completing three medal rounds signed by a full member.
8. A Taster member, with an official club handicap, is entitled to play in Wednesdays competitions and open competitions and is eligible to win a prize as determined by the Competitions committee for that competition. Please check eligibility with the Club Professional prior to taking a start time.
9. A Taster member is entitled to use the Practice Areas free of charge Monday to Sunday.
10. A Taster member is entitled to use the Clubhouse and all its facilities Monday to Sunday.
11. Entrance Fees and Subscriptions will be agreed annually at the AGM. Payment methods will be the same for all categories of membership.
12. A Taster member may apply for a permanent membership during the two month period. A Taster Member who makes a successful application for a permanent membership will have the £50.00 fee deducted from their subscription or their joining fee/membership fee (Full member). When a permanent type of

membership is accepted a bar card offering bar discounts will be issued.

13. A Taster member may not attend club meetings, vote at the AGM or take part in the management of the Club.

14. The Council reserves the right to vary its terms and conditions as it deems necessary from time to time.

15. We ask all Taster members to respect our course and give some brief course etiquette below.

- Please repair divots, pitch marks and rake bunkers after use.
- Please keep all trolleys off the teeing areas and the greens.
- Please be aware and respect other golfers around you.
- Please read carefully the guidance rules for the clubhouse and the course and ensure you are familiar with them before you play

15. Any person who agrees to join the Club and pays the subscription has accepted all these terms and conditions.
