

JUNIOR MEMBERS

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- A junior member shall be entitled to play on any day. The Council have imposed certain constraints on juniors whenever a full member's competition is being played. Please refer to Club diary for details.
- 2. A junior member is not entitled to attend meetings, vote at the AGM or take part in the management of the Club.
- 3. Junior members with a handicap of 12 or less are entitled to play in **major club competitions**. They will pay a token entrance fee and will only be entitled to win a token prize. Juniors **cannot** play in the **Captain's Final**.

Juniors may be selected to represent the Club in outside competitions where rules permit. Juniors with a handicap of 12 or under may enter the **Club Championship**. They will pay a full entrance fee and be entitled to win the competition.

Juniors with a handicap of 12 or under may enter **Summer Singles Competitions**. They will pay a token entrance fee and be entitled to win a token prize.

Any Junior playing in a Club competition must play with an adult member in the three-ball. Specific junior competitions are normally played on Sundays. See club diary for details.

- 4. A junior member is entitled to introduce visitors at a reduced fee. Any one visitor is only entitled to play 6 times in any one calendar year at the reduced rate.
- 5. A junior member is entitled to use the practise areas at any time the course is open to full members.
- 6. A junior member is entitled to make full use of the Clubhouse and its facilities as per the Club diary. N.B. Dress rules, including footwear apply at all times.
- 7. Entrance Fees and subscriptions will be reviewed at the AGM. Payment methods will be the same for all categories of membership
- 8. Every junior member is expected to register his/her name in the appropriate register kept in the Professionals shop. This only applies if the junior is not accompanied by an adult.
- 9. Every category of club member is expected to read the club diary and familiarise themselves with the club rules. Every category of member is subject to the same code of behaviour and dress rules as laid down in the diary.
- 10. Every category of member is subject to the same disciplinary procedures as laid down in the Articles of Association.
- 11. The Council reserves the right to review all of these terms and conditions as required.
- 12. Anyone who agrees to join the club agrees to all these terms and conditions.
