

## RESTRICTED 3 DAY MEMBER

### TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. A restricted 3 day member shall be entitled to play on: Monday, Tuesday and Friday. When the course is booked up on any of the above days the member may obtain a suitable alternative/ tee time from the Professional who will have appropriate control of course usage.
2. A 3 day member is **not** eligible to play in Club competitions. Except: Club Open Competitions held on a Tuesday and Am/Am's held on a Friday. NB a current Handicap is required.
3. A 3 day member will not have any membership rights but may at any time apply to become a Member through the usual procedure.
4. The Council may at times give priority to bookings from Visitors, Societies etc. It is advisable for **all** members to check with the Club Professional (01925 762943 Option 1) before playing to avoid disappointment. The times when the course is booked can be found on the Course Notice Board and the BRS tee booking system.
5. A restricted 3 day member is entitled to introduce three visitors at the reduced rate on: Mondays, Tuesdays, and Fridays. Any one visitor is only entitled to play 6 times in any one calendar year at the reduced rate.
6. A 3 day member may apply for a handicap certificate on completing three medal rounds signed by a Full member.
7. A 3 day member with Club Handicap, is entitled to play in open competitions but not on a Wednesday or Saturday. Please check eligibility with the Club Professional prior to taking a start time.
8. A restricted 3 day member is entitled to use the practise areas free of charge on: Mondays, Tuesdays, and Fridays.
9. A restricted 3 day member is entitled to make full use of the Clubhouse and its facilities for the full 7 days.
10. Entrance Fees and subscriptions will be reviewed at the AGM. Payment methods will be the same for all categories of membership
11. Every category of club member is expected to read the club diary and familiarise themselves with the club rules. Every category of member is subject to the same code of behaviour and dress rules as laid down in the diary.
12. The Council reserves the right to review all of these terms and conditions as required.
13. Anyone who agrees to join the club agrees to all these terms and conditions.
