## Teams and Qualification

-There will be a maximum of 12 designated Competitions over the coming months that will make up the qualifying period.
-In each Competition points will be awarded to the top 10 from each Division. 1st place receiving 10 pts, 2nd place 9 pts down to 10 th place who will receive 1 point. This will apply in both Divisions (Div 1 = Handicap Index Scratch to 21.9 \& Div 2 = Hnadicap Index 22.0 to 36.6 ). -Any competitor with a Handicap Index of more than 36.6 may enter, but if they qualify for the Final their Handicap Index will be reduced before their Course Handicap is calculated.

- A regular updated leader board will be displayed in the Clubhouse.
-The players total score will be their 6 best returns from any of the designated competitions.
-The leading 6 players from each Division will Qualify for the Solheim Cup, plus one 'wild card' choice each for LC \& LVC
$\bullet$ Teams and Pairings for Sunday's Four-ball matches will be announced the week before.
-Pairings for Sunday Singles matches will be announced after the Fourball matches.
- In this Competition you will stay and score in the Division you first scored points in.
